Summary

- God is in charge, even when it doesn't look like it. The Lord of the world wants us to join Him in his saving, restoring and healing work.
- The spirit of God is active in the world, and experiences every bit of pain and suffering. God loves the world, but love gives people freedom to choose life or death. His vision is a world of abundant life.
- Partner with the spirit in the world. You are uniquely created by God. As his workmanship, we have good works to do with Jesus in the world he loves.
- Discern the Holy Spirit in mission. Learning to trust God means saying yes to God leading us into
 places of risk, with his help. As the Holy Spirit teaches us what to say and do when we need to
 know.
- Jesus only did what he saw the father doing. You and I can join the Father in fulfilling his mission in the world by cultivation a relationship with the Holy Spirit.
